Upon request of the Senator, he met with Daw Aung San Suu Kyi at Seinle Kantha State House in Yangon on 15 August 2009, since her trial at the court is over.

In addition, at the request of Mr. Jim Webb and the Embassy of the United States of America to Myanmar, an order was issued for US citizen Mr. John William Yettaw, who was serving a seven-year prison term, to serve only half of his prison term and that the remaining prison term to be suspended and subsequently to be deported on humanitarian grounds and as a gesture of taking heed of relations between the US and Myanmar. Mr. John William Yettaw left Yangon, Myanmar by air in the afternoon of 16 August 2009 together with Senator Mr. Jim Webb.

Before his departure from Myanmar, the Senator met with journalists from Myanmar Foreign Correspondents Club and editorial staff from journals and magazines at the lounge of Yangon International Airport. The Senator Mr. Jim Webb explained the purpose of visiting Myanmar and replied to the queries raised by correspondents.
